Vision RNG partnered with waste management company Meridian Waste Acquisitions to install renewable natural gas production facilities at its landfills, the company <u>announced</u> on Thursday.

Meridian Waste Acquisitions is one of the three landfills <u>Vision</u> RNG has already under contract. The developer <u>plans to</u> have between 10 and 15 small and medium size landfills under contract by the end of its first year of operations.

The facilities, which are currently under construction, are expected to reach substantial by the beginning of 2023, when Vision RNG aims to produce up to 800,000 MMBtus of RNG.

The landfills are located across Missouri and Virginia.

Vision RNG is a newly formed landfill gas infrastructure developer backed by <u>Vision Ridge Partners</u>' Sustainable Asset Fund II.
