You will be responsible for implementing, monitoring safety programs and procedures, providing safety related training to employees to create a safe work environment and monitor contractor compliance.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Ensure all company operations adhere to safety regulations and standards relevant to the renewable natural gas industry.
- Visit project sites to evaluate progress and respond to Project Manager, Contractor, and Customer safety related questions, issues and or concerns.
- Perform safety and quality inspections for on-going projects and completed projects utilizing checklist and or other safety related programs to identify and mitigate potential hazards and risks.
- Develop and deliver safety training programs to employees, contractors, and visitors, emphasizing best practices and regulatory compliance.
- Participate in accident/incident investigations, root cause, EH&S audits, regulatory inspections, and other components of the Environmental, Health and Safety System. Assist in the preparation of safety reports and maintain records of safety-related incidents and activities.
- Assist in maintaining safety policies and procedures, keeping them up to date with industry standards and legal requirements.
- Implement emergency response plans and drills to ensure preparedness in case of emergencies.
- Promote a culture of safety and responsibility among all employees and contractors.
- Stay up to date with environmental, health, and safety regulations, ensuring the company's compliance.

Requirements:

- A degree in Environmental Science, Occupational Safety, or a related field is preferred.
- 2-4 years of proven experience in safety management within the renewable energy, natural gas, gas processing, power, or other industry with similar operating practices.
- Certification in Occupational Health and Safety (e.g., CSP, ASP, OHST) is preferred.

- Excellent communication and training skills.
- Strong problem-solving abilities and attention to details and a commitment to safety.
- Ability to work in the field at construction sites and adapt to various working conditions which include extreme heat and cold.
